Harvest Date: October 15

Brix: 24.5

Yeast: Syrah

Barrel Aging: 18 months combination of new and neutral French and American oak

Fermentation: A warm 14 day primary in stainless steel tanks followed by a two week malolactic fermentation in barrels.

T/A – 5.6 gr/L pH – 3.87

Alcohol: 13.9 % by vol.
